

Dear Concordia Pro Life students and parents,

For the past decade God has blessed our efforts to defend human life, and our growing presence at the National March for Life in DC is evidence of this. The next march will take place at the end of January, and the purpose of this communication is to provide you with what information we do know in order to equip you as a family for whatever decision you ultimately make.

First, there is no option for our "traditional" school trip to DC. All other participating schools have opted out due to the complexity of the situation. However, Right to Life of Northeast Indiana is still planning to provide transportation for those interested in their Family Trip, which first ran at the previous march (January, 2020) with great success. Alternatively, you could decide to attend the 2021 National March as a family, providing your own transportation and sleeping accommodations.

Regardless of the method of transportation, we will ask any student attending the 2021 National March for Life to plan to quarantine for a period of up to 14 days upon their return to Fort Wayne, before returning to in-person learning on campus. We support any family's decision to peacefully defend human life, and we hope you understand our responsibility as a school community to minimize the spread of Covid-19 when a greater risk of exposure is unavoidable.
