Even though I was born on the Autism Spectrum and suffered great difficulties in my youth, I will never regret being born, because that adversity, that struggle, made me who I am today and taught me that with a good education, a proper mindset and a strong support system, we can overcome anything. Those are the values I want to impart on my community's students. They are capable of making the choices to succeed by embracing a classical humanist education. I have faith they will find the right choice for them.

As far as the roll of abortions in the school, I do not support any organizations outside of accredited academic institutions to make presentations or attempt to solicit from students. However, this question must be discussed not through the lens of any religion, but secular moral philosophy. If we are to reduce the number of abortions, concessions must absolutely be made. We cannot let perfection get in the way of progress. For me to in good conscious support the items on the survey, Right to Life would do well to support parenting classes, in school daycares, and therapy for new mothers, as well as additional support for young mothers to give their children up for adoption. To a point, my beliefs overlap with advocates of pro life and that point is ensuring that our communities' children are properly supported in their choice to raise or adopt.

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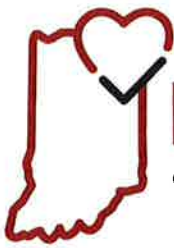
