4:00 am approx. - Bus arrives at Right to Life, 2126 Inwood Dr, Fort Wayne, IN 46815

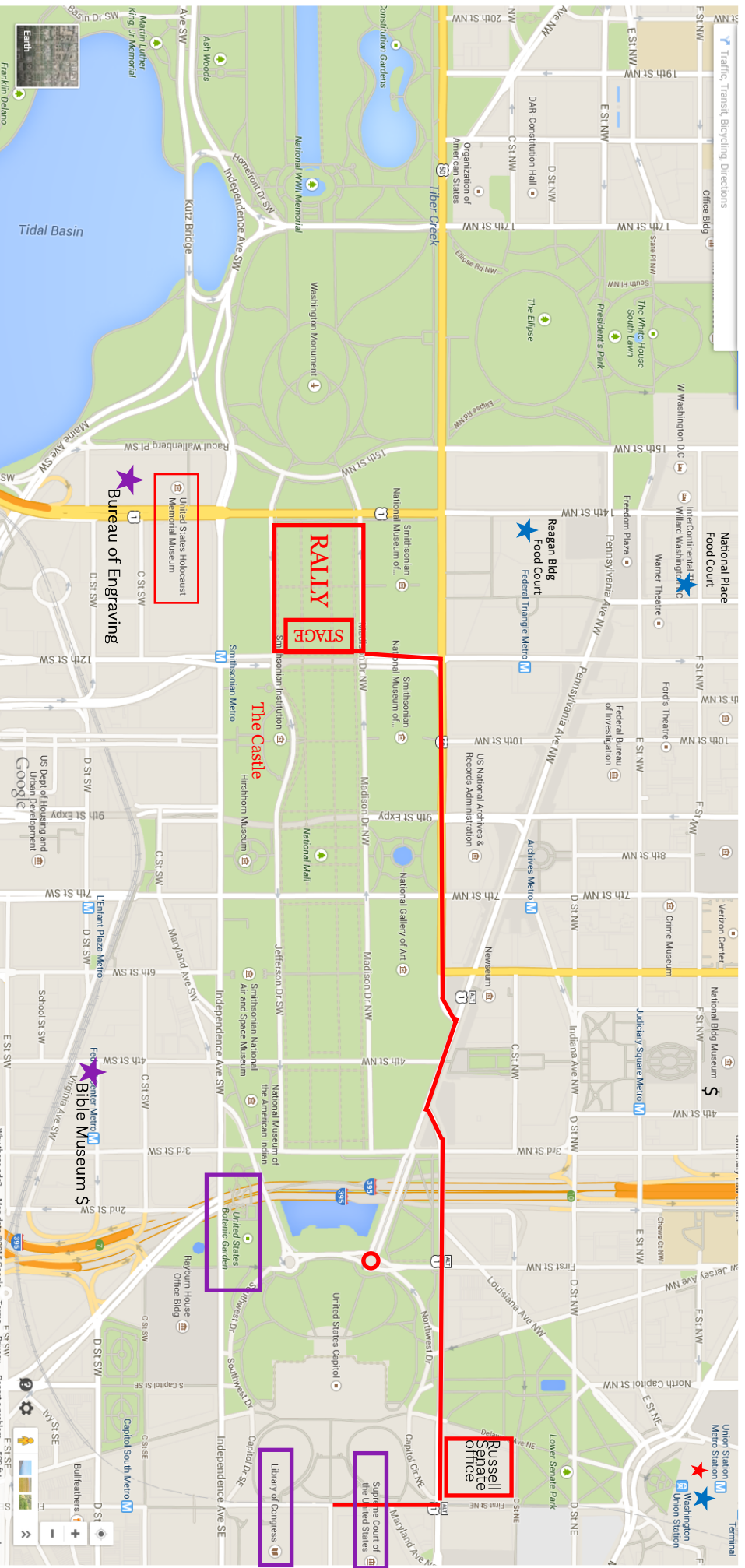

WASHINGTON D.C. SECURITY:

Each time we enter a government building we will need to go through security. In order to expedite security please do not, the following items are strictly prohibited:

- liquid, including water (in capitol)
- food or beverage of any kind, including fruit and unopened packaged food (in capitol)
- aerosol containers
- non-aerosol spray
- any pointed object (pens, pencils permitted)
- any bag larger than 18" w x 14" h x 8.5" d
- electric stun guns, martial arts weapons
- guns, replica guns, ammunition, and fireworks
- knives of any size

- mace and pepper spray
 - razors and box cutters
- The less stuff you bring/smaller the bag you carry, the easier security will be.

NOTE: If you try to bring something in that is not allowed they will not hold it for you. If they have to take it, consider it gone.
