8. To help us better understand your pro-life position could you please tell us why you consider yourself to be pro-life, if you have pro-life qualifications that would be helpful for us to know and how you plan to use your elected position to support life.

When I was 15 years old, my mom explained to me that she'd gotten pregnant with me at age 17. Her boyfriend first dumped her, but later, realizing his part in her situation would soon become obvious to all, he offered to help her by driving her to a Clinic and paying for an abortion. Having no other source of support, she agreed. After the doc's exam, Mom noticed she was bleeding and assumed the procedure had been done. This shocked her from the state of ambivalence she'd been in - she was immediately ashamed and filled with regret. But God was there, and it was His plan to move her this way. For reasons we will never understand apart from God's hand of protection, the doc had decided he couldn't perform the procedure. I have always believed in the sanctity of all human life, and this knowledge of my own history has only bolstered my opinion. As a young adult, I volunteered
