Right to Life of Northeast Indiana ETF is hosting a debate "Elective Abortion is a Moral Wong" as the start to Life Defenders on July 10, 6pm. All parents are invited to the debate and are welcome to sit with their student(s). The \$5 tickets can be purchased at www.ichooselife.org/debate

While Right to Life of Northeast Indiana is hosting the event, please be advised that the statements made by the participants do not necessarily reflect the positions of Right to Life of Northeast Indiana. The affirmative side is being represented by Seth Dryer of Created Equal who is a phenomenal voice for life and one of our instructors at Life Defenders.

The contrary position (pro abortion) is being represented by a local advocate and candidate for Allen County Council, Erin Fogg. In June, in conjunction with the Black Lives Matter protests in downtown Fort Wayne, Erin Fogg was arrested for planning violence. She has not been convicted and holds that she used only peaceful protest.

We will have uniformed police officers present at the debate and no tolerance for disorderly conduct from anyone. Individuals who are unruly or disrespectful will be immediately escorted out of the auditorium.

Fogg does have a tendency to use foul language (including profanity) in normal conversation which we realize is not what we want our students hearing. It is, however, a reality we often see inside the prolife prochoice dialog.

You have the option of allowing your student to attend the debate which we believe will be a wonderful educational opportunity to see exactly how it looks when minds on each side of the abortion debate meet. Those students whose parents opt them out of the debate will be in a classroom watching a pro life film, *Allison's Choice*, while the debate is happening and will join back with the Life Defenders afterwards.

Parents have 2 additional ways to be involved in this educational opportunity with their students. The 1st is purchasing a \$5 ticket to the debate and attending with your student(s). The 2nd is watching the recording of the debate post Life Defenders at your convenience.

If you opt your student(s) out of the debate audience, they will watch a prolife video in one of our classrooms. Please call me with questions or concerns.
