Mother's Day Carnation Project Policy

Purpose

Your support of our organization through one of our top 3 fundraisers helps continue our work in our 8 counties promoting and defending innocent human life through education, advocacy, and public policy.

Benefit for your Church Community

The Mothers will be blessed to have a gift of a beautiful carnation and a "thank you" for saying "yes" to LIFE!

Here is how the project works

1. Order the number of carnations needed for your church community by April 1st.
2. Price per stem is \$2.
3. Your church will be invoiced for the cost of the carnation.
4. Your church can purchase the carnations ahead of Mother's Day and then add a free will donation for the day of Mother's Day.
5. Carnations are picked up at 3106 Lake Ave, Fort Wayne, 210 Highpointe Crossing, Kendallville, or 1300 N Main St, Bluffton.
6. Buckets and funds are asked to be returned within 2 weeks of Mother's Day (unless other arrangements have been made with our organization).
7. The day the carnations are distributed, kindly have a pulpit announcement, a bulletin ad and/or a chance for a representative to speak on our behalf about the purpose of the project.
8. We will provide this information a month before Mother's Day.

Example

If your church orders 500 carnations and the church pays \$1000.00, then your church would meet the requirements for the order.

If your church orders 500 carnations and the free will donation collected is \$500 then the church would make up the difference of the \$500.

If your church orders 500 carnations and the free will donation totals \$1200. The \$1200 would be the donation sent to our organization.
