RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF HUMAN LIFE

WHEREAS Life is the first declared right in the Declaration of Independence which our Founders affirmed, "We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are **LIFE**, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness." and

WHEREAS the Huntertown Town Council believes the protection of all human life is important to the people of the Town of Huntertown; and

WHEREAS the Huntertown Town Council believes every human life is unique and precious to God and humankind; and

WHEREAS the Huntertown Town Council believes human life begins at the moment of conception and continues, uninterrupted, until the moment of natural death; and


WHEREAS the Huntertown Town Council believes human life must be protected and preserved.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND DECLARED BY THE HUNTERTOWN TOWN COUNCIL IN HUNTERTOWN, INDIANA, that human life, including the unborn, must always be valued and protected, and that society must protect those who cannot protect themselves.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Huntertown Town Council encourages assisting pregnant women find health care and sources for other needs; helping mothers and fathers who make the decision to parent their child find assistance if needed; supporting mothers and fathers who make an adoption plan for their child and couples who seek to adopt; encourage the installation of Safe Haven baby boxes and encouraging businesses and schools to provide appropriate accommodations for pregnant women and mothers.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the **HUNTERTOWN TOWN COUNCIL** encourages our state and federal governments to use every legal means to protect and fight for every human life, including the lives of unborn boys and girls.
