

20. To help us better understand your pro-life position could you please tell us why you consider yourself to be pro-life, if you have pro-life qualifications that would be helpful for us to know and how you plan to use your elected position to support life.

My pro-life position can be easily summed up this way: We as a society have the responsibility to defend the most vulnerable among us. If a child in the womb can be considered less than human because he or she is an inconvenience for the mother or others, then murder for reason of convenience can be applied to other vulnerable populations as well. If this line of reasoning is carried to its logical conclusion, the mentally handicapped, the elderly, the sick and even the unruly can be done away with. The value of life is diminished when the defenseless become disposable. This genocide is among us now, and will expand to every age group if we allow it to continue. This is the most important issue of our generation.

At the local government level, officials have a direct responsibility for requiring abortion facilities to meet every building safety code and every health care standard required of a hospital. We must protect both mothers and children from predatory organizations like Planned Parenthood by requiring that every local health and safety code apply to them, as those codes apply to any surgical center.

I am the youngest candidate running in the 2019 city election cycle. I have attended two March For Life events, over the past several years. While I realize this isn't enough, I can say that I
